

Standardized Dress Guide

2009 - 2010

Grade PK - 12th



Visible **drawstrings** on pants, shorts, skorts, or capris **not allowed**

Torn clothing not allowed

Leggings/tights are allowed under attire that meets uniform specifications. Leggings/tights may only be solid navy, black or white

Elementary, Middle and High Schools

Standardized Dress consist of: Khaki, navy blue, or black solid shorts, skirts, skorts, jumpers/dress, capris, or trousers; also, solid white or navy blue long or short sleeved blouses and shirts with collar.

High school students also have an option of wearing the designated school color shirt or blouse noted as the following:

United High School: Orange **Alexander High School: Gold** **United South High: Carolina Blue** **L.B. Johnson High School: Purple**

TOPS Shirts must have **collars and sleeves** and may be **polo-style or dress-style**. **Turtlenecks** shall be allowed. Manufacturers' logos/trademarks, if any, must be one inch or less. **Snaps or zippers** on shirts are **not** allowed. **All shirts must be tucked in**

PANTS Attire must fit well and not be oversized or undersized; must fit at the waist and must not sag

BELTS Attire with belt loops require **belts** for students in grades 3rd through 12th

LENGTH **Shorts, skirts, skorts and jumpers/dresses** must be no shorter than three inches above the knee. Slits on garments can be no more than 3 inches above the knee

OUTERWEAR All sweatshirts, jackets, sweaters and sweater vests must be worn over a standard dress-approved shirt/blouse. Outerwear garments are acceptable in any color and may or may not have hood/hoodie; however, they must have buttons or zippers. **No pullover sweatshirts** with or without hoods will be allowed. The hood/hoodie will not be allowed to be worn inside the school building. Official letterman jackets, school jackets, and school logos on outerwear garments are permitted provided such jackets or logos correspond with the school in which such garments are worn.

BOTTOMS **Pockets of pants/shorts, skirts, capris, skorts** must be the standard front pockets. **Baggies, low rise, or loose-fit pants** as well as **jeans, denim, cargo, carpenter, painter, overalls, bell bottoms or wide – leg style pants, velour/sweat pants and warm-ups** are **not** allowed

FOOTWEAR House slippers, flip flops, steel or hard plastic-toe shoes/boots, skate shoes and shoes that may pose safety hazards are **not** allowed

HEADGEAR No hats, caps, skull caps, scarves, bandanas **NOT WORN INSIDE BUILDING** ● Sunglasses ● Hoods/Hoodie
